Hundreds of colorful kites will fill the skies over Livingston Middle School for the 7th Annual Knights of Columbus "Time to Fly" Kite Festival, Sunday April 8, from 9 a.m. - 4 p.m. This **FREE event** is a celebration of professional and leisure kite fliers with some of the most colorful giant "show kites" that can be shaped as planes, birds, dogs, pirate ships and even octopuses. The Merced County Sheriff's Huey Helicopter will land to kick off the event and the **First 500 Kids get a free Kite** so get there early. The Kite Festival is presented by Livingston Community Health, Radio Lobo and K97.5.

Livingston Community Health will provide a free preventative screenings and resources for the community. Come get your FREE blood glucose and blood pressure checks.

Join us for this year's kite flying festivities that will include GIANT Kite Flying Demonstrations, kite-Building workshops, **Kite Building Contests**, and the "Jim Strelay" Memorial Sugar-Free Candy Drop and for the second year we, will have a Rubik's Cube solving contest! Other activities include the Rotary Club of Livingston Pie Eating Contest, Face Painting, Bounce Houses, Crafts, Kite, and informational Vendor booths, plus various cultural performances and safety demonstrations from PG&E, Livingston Police and Fire, CHP, and Merced County Sheriff.

Each year, in anticipation of the kite festival, the Knights of Columbus have kite building days at the local Head starts pre-schools. This year will be no different as we will have the kite building days the week prior to the Kite Festival. When the weather is ideal, crowds can exceed 4,000 people.

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**VENDOR GUIDELINES**

**CONDITIONS/INFORMATION**

1. **NO KITE** Vendor Applications will be accepted for this event.
2. **NO SALES OF BOTTLED WATER/DRINKS, or KITES WILL BE PERMITTED.** They will be exclusive to the Knights of Columbus and organizers of event.
3. All vendors **encouraged** to donate a raffle prize and will be mentioned and thanked from stage.
4. It is **mandatory** to include self-addressed stamped (\$.49) envelope for return correspondence.
5. **If your application is accepted;** we will call you to confirm your participation within 2 weeks of receiving application.
6. You will only be allowed sell **approved items** from your list and **cannot** add other items!
7. All activity is restricted to your booth. Wandering sales or distribution of flyers will not be permitted.
8. Booths are assigned and accepted per guidelines set forth by Knights of Columbus. **Please do not ask for any exceptions!** The Knights of Columbus reserves the right to refuse any vendor.
9. Bring your own tables, chairs, and Canopies etc. They will not be provided for you.
10. There is no electricity available to vendors. If you want electricity you will have to bring your own generator. **NO EXCEPTIONS. (See application generator guidelines)**
11. Keep and leave your booth and surrounding areas clean. **You MUST provide a trash container both inside and outside your booth.**
12. All booths must be anchored down, vendor will be held responsible for any damage caused by unanchored booths. For booths on asphalt bring appropriate weights.
13. Items which use our guests as entertainment will not be allowed. **These items include but are not limited to; weapons, AIR SOFT GUNS, silly string, disappearing ink, and poppers.**
14. **NO PETS or ICE CHESTS WILL BE ALLOWED IN FESTIVAL. VENDOR ICE CHEST WILL BE SUBJECT TO INSPECTIONS.** Periodic inspections of booths and ice chests may be done.
15. Numerous Vendor duplications may be limited. Booth spaces will be accepted on a "first come, first serve" basis.
16. **Set-up** is to take place Sunday April 8, between 7:00am and 8:30am. *(If you are not ready by 8:30 am deposit may be forfeited).*
17. **For Safety, No vehicles** will be allowed in the park between 8:30am and 4pm (during the event). *(If leave early, you will have to carry your items to your vehicle and deposit will be forfeited).*
18. Food Vendors must submit Merced County Health Permit Application along Merced county fee and this application to Knights of Columbus. *(Separate check for \$90 must be made to Merced County Health Department).*
19. Food Vendor Applications must be submitted **by March 23, 2018.**
20. Non-Food vendor applications must be submitted by March 23, any application received after March 23, will be charged an additional \$50 fee.
21. All Food Vendors must provide liability insurance. Naming City of Livingston, Livingston Union School District, and Knights of Columbus 9363 as additional insured. *(Please call for additional details).*
